

## St Edward's Catholic Primary School PE and sport premium for primary schools

### PE and Sport Premium

At St Edward's School we believe that physical education, experienced in a safe and supportive environment, is a unique and vital contributor to a pupil's physical development and well-being. A broad and balanced physical education curriculum is intended to provide for pupils' increasing self-confidence in their ability to manage themselves and their bodies within a variety of movement situations. Progressive learning objectives, combined with sympathetic and varied teaching approaches, endeavour to provide stimulating, enjoyable, satisfying and appropriately challenging learning experiences for all pupils. Through the selection of suitable differentiation and logically developed tasks, it is intended that pupils, irrespective of their innate ability, shall enjoy success and be motivated to develop further their individual potential and take part in lifelong physical activity.

In March 2013 the government announced that it was to provide additional funding of **£150 million per annum** for academic years 2013 to 2014 and 2014 to 2015 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools in England - The **Primary PE & Sport Premium**. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - is allocated to primary school Head Teachers and is solely spent on the provision of PE and sport in schools.

St Edward's received confirmation notification for the 2015/16 sports grant totalling £9,770. This was paid in 2 parts, from the period of Sept 2015 to March 2016 in the sum of £5,699, and to cover the period of April to August 2016 the sum of £4,071. Additional funds from the school's PE budget were made available to enhance further access to sporting activities to enable further progression in opportunities given to pupils.

### Impact of PE and Sport Premium

- There is a structured training programme for staff through team teaching with specialist coaches
- Partnership with **West Ham Football Club** delivers a high quality physical education as part of the curriculum as the club provides highly qualified coaches to deliver multi sports sessions at the School, which in turn increases the opportunities that our children get to compete in competitive school sports. The children absolutely love the WHU coaches as they are always enthusiastic and go above and beyond to stretch and inspire our children.
- We are a member of the **Langdon Academy Sport Partnership** which allows access to Partnership competitions, NQT Support and Network meetings which keeps members up to date of any Government and NGBs strategies.

St Edward's will continue to use the PE and Sport Premium to enter more competitions, participate in the Langdon Academy Sport Partnership, invest in more specialist coaches and continue to raise the standards of PE in the school.
