Intent

Our Modern Foreign Language curriculum aims to promote a positive attitude towards language learning and provide the children with a firm foundation for relevant studies at secondary school. The main language taught in our school is French, with an emphasis on skills useful in language learning in general.



Yrs 3, 4, 5 and 6 have one dedicated MFL lesson a week. We rely on the *KS2 Framework for Languages (DfES 2005)* to meet the relevant requirements of the National Curriculum. Careful planning ensures skills progression and equitable access, with continual adjustment in response to formative assessment. Content is revisited to ensure long-term learning. Positive attitudes are promoted via enjoyable and stimulating lessons.

Impact

Anecdotally, children enjoy French. Weekly evaluation of skills, knowledge, motivation and confidence informs planning. Termly teacher assessment of each child against the Framework's expected outcomes allows discrepancies to be addressed.
