Dance

Each Dance and KS2 Gymnastics unit within our scheme of work is cross linked with a subject.

EYFS- Ourselves (PSHE)

Year 1-Growing (Science/Music)

Year 1 pupils will create rhythms and movements with their bodies and perform motifs that represent the life cycle of a plant.

Year 2-Explorers (History)

Pupils will use emotion and expression whilst they create movements that represent an explorer preparing for an expedition.

Year 3-Weather (Science)

Pupils will create movements that demonstrate a change in the weather.

Wild Animals (Science)

Pupils will move in character as a wild animal.

Year4-Space (Science)


Pupils will create sequences to portray astronauts exploring a new planet.

Year 5-Greeks (Science)

Pupils will create movements that represent their chosen Greek God.

Year 6-Carnival (Music)

Pupils will learn the basic Samba steps and perform focusing on the rhythm.



Gymnastics

Year 3-Symmetry and Asymmetry (Maths)

Pupils will create symmetrical ways of moving.

Year 4- Bridges (Geography)

Pupils will create individual bridge balances on apparatus. They will share their prior knowledge about bridges and their structure.

Year 6-Matching and Mirroring (Maths)

Pupils will create a mini sequence of matching movements with a partner on apparatus.
