Expectations of Behaviour



Golden ticket
A Golden ticket is awarded, once 15 Golden letters have been achieved within the class.
This entitles the class to golden time.



Gold star
Exceptional behaviour
Children on gold star at end of day receive a golden letter



Silver star
Continued good behaviour throughout the day.
Children on silver star at the end of the day receive a post card.



Bronze star
Good behaviour seen through the day
Children on bronze star receive 5 house points.



Green Light Traffic
All children start on the green traffic light every morning.



Amber traffic light - despite receiving a number of reminders about positive ways of behaving, there has not been an improvement in child's attitude to learning, the child is moved to amber.
While on amber, teachers focus on catching the child being good so to move back to green.



Red traffic light - if there has been no improvement in the attitude to learning, while the child has been on amber and a number of reminders about positive ways of behaving has been given, the child is moved to red.
While on red, teachers continue to focus on catching the child being good so to move back to green. Further reminders are given but if there is still no improvement, at this point the child is subject to a red letter.

We hope this positive reward system will encourage our pupils to maintain and improve the exceptional behaviour we already see in the school. In addition, it is hope that it will also develop the culture of collaboration as a class, in that the quicker the children attain 15 Golden Letters, the quicker the class will enjoy Golden time together. Thereby creating a culture of work hard but also play hard together.
It is expected that every pupil will achieve a golden letter and post card at least once.



GOSPEL - MATTHEW 20:1-16



1 'Now the kingdom of Heaven is like a landowner going out at daybreak to hire workers for his vineyard.
 2 He made an agreement with the workers for one denarius a day and sent them to his vineyard.
 3 Going out at about the third hour he saw others standing idle in the market place
 4 and said to them, "You go to my vineyard too and I will give you a fair wage."
 5 So they went. At about the sixth hour and again at about the ninth hour, he went out and did the same.
 6 Then at about the eleventh hour he went out and found more men standing around, and he said to them, "Why have you been standing here idle all day?"
 7 "Because no one has hired us," they answered. He said to them, "You go into my vineyard too."
 8 In the evening, the owner of the vineyard said to his bailiff, "Call the workers and pay them their wages, starting with the last arrivals and ending with the first."

9 So those who were hired at about the eleventh hour came forward and received one denarius each.
 10 When the first came, they expected to get more, but they too received one denarius each.
 11 They took it, but grumbled at the landowner saying,
 12 "The men who came last have done only one hour, and you have treated them the same as us, though we have done a heavy day's work in all the heat."
 13 He answered one of them and said, "My friend, I am not being unjust to you; did we not agree on one denarius?
 14 Take your earnings and go. I choose to pay the lastcomer as much as I pay you.
 15 Have I no right to do what I like with my own? Why should you be envious because I am generous?"
 16 Thus the last will be first, and the first, last.'


Year 6 Priest Form Dates
