COVID-19 Home/School Agreement - June 2020



SCHOOL:

As a school we will do our best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can.
- Provide learning opportunities which support the children's academic, social, emotional, physical and spiritual development as well as nurturing their well-being with equal content provided for those pupils learning from home.
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19.
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'Bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement.
- Communicate between home and school through Parent Pay, newsletters and the school website.

PARENTS/CARERS:

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child or anyone in my household shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- If my child or another child in the group shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately.
- On my commute and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- Only use public transport if absolutely necessary and ensure I socially distance and wear a face covering if I do.

- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child.
- My child must not bring any items into school with them other than a labelled water bottle or take items home from school.
- I will take my child's temperature before they arrive at school and understand it will be taken during the day if they feel or present as being unwell.
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully.
- My child will need to use good respiratory (using a tissue when sneezing or coughing and putting it in the bin straight away – catch it, bin it, kill it) and hand hygiene (comply with regular handwashing for 20 seconds throughout the school day using soap and water or sanitiser).
- As a parent I will not be allowed into the school – please contact us via telephone or email.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contact details.
- I understand if my child is deemed unsafe he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

PUPILS:

To ensure that everyone in the school environment is safe I will:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground.
- Tell an adult immediately if I feel unwell.
- Not bring things into school from home or take things home from school.
- Only use the equipment provided to me by school.
- Not mix with any children outside of my bubble in the school.
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate.
- Follow good respiratory hygiene -coughing and sneezing into a tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it).
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds and where necessary use hand sanitiser.
- Only use public transport if absolutely necessary and ensure I socially distance and wear a face covering if I do.
- If I am a Year 6 pupil and I am given permission to walk to and from school, I will try and do so with other children from my 'Bubble'.
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others.
- Follow these expectations and know that if I do not I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
