The attached spending from St Edward's School using The PE Sport Premium shows expenditure for the amount of £9,123 based on the gross amount received of £8,117.00 on Tuesday 15th May 2018 for The PE & Sports Grant 17/18 Academic year. The costings show the plan for exactly how these funds will be delegated to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of physical education at St Edward's school. The money has been received on Tuesday 15th May 2018 and the attached figures show exactly where this money will be spent.

Impact of PE and Sport Premium

The PE Sport Premium is a fundamental aspect of enhancing sports in our school. As per the guidance given to all primary schools that receive the funding, we try to ensure that we use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of physical education (PE), and sports that we offer.

This means that as per the guidelines given to primary schools, we use the premium to:

- Develop or add to the PE, physical activity and sport activities that your school already offers
- Build capacity and capability within the school to ensure that improvements made now will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.

Based on previous years and looking at our plan for the future, here are some of the current benefits of the PE and Sport Premium within our school:

- All children have the opportunity to participate in sporting activities at lunchtime
- St Edward's enters all borough inter-schools competitions
- St Edward's are currently placing in the 'top positions' at competitions
- PE standards are exceptionally high at St Edward's, substantiated by the school data
- There is a structured training programme for staff through team teaching with specialist coaches
- Partnership with **West Ham Football Club** delivers a high quality physical education as part of the curriculum as the club provides highly qualified coaches to deliver multi sports

sessions at the School, which in turn increases the opportunities that our children get to compete in competitive school sports. The children absolutely love the WHU coaches as they are always enthusiastic and go above and beyond to stretch and inspire our children.

- We are a member of the **Langdon Academy Sport Partnership** which allows access to Partnership competitions, NQT Support and Network meetings which keeps members up to date of any Government and NGBs strategies.

Our target for future spending is the following:

Provide staff with professional development, mentoring, training and resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively and embed physical activity across our school – St Edward's will be thinking about buying into a new scheme of work for teaching PE that can be rolled out across the whole school.

St Edward's will continue to use the PE and Sport Premium to enter more competitions, participate in the Langdon Academy Sport Partnership, invest in more specialist coaches and continue to raise the standards of PE in the school.
